**SERVICE OFFICER:** During the 2020-2021 service officer year (May1-April 30) our service officers Spoke with 1760 veterans, spent 3440 hours and logged 11760 miles. I want to thank all the service officers for the hard work they do. Veterans who were previously denied service connection for an herbicide related presumptive condition, due to lack of incountry Vietnam service will have their claims automatically re-adjudicated by VA. The department began re-adjudicating claims in April for Veterans who served in the offshore waters of the Republic of Vietnam during the Vietnam War but were denied for one or more herbicide related conditions, on the basis that military service was not performed on the landmass of the Republic of Vietnam or on its inland waterways. The review also applies to eligible survivors of deceased Vietnamera Veterans. For more info or questions contact your friendly service officers. injuries.

Complete with gyroscopes for center of gravity, computerization for control and twin lighter weight lithium battery power packs. I-bots can go 6.5 mph and 17 miles! Other information is that the HVAMC is optimistically awaiting the "green light" to open its doors to volunteers. Please consider becoming a volunteer.
