SERVICE OFFICER: In the month of April, 7 Service Officers reported that 3 Intents to File Claim were submitted, 49 New Claims were submitted and spoke to 195 Veterans or active duty with advice on how to proceed with their claims. A total of 325 hours was logged and a total of 1,012 miles were driven. Rickey Brown and Anne Starke attended a seminar and training session for the United Way/ Mission United - UNITEUS. We have completed a license agreement with them to participate in a program to bring many organizations together to assist our Veterans. We will be able to communicate with the other organizations through a website created by Mission United/United Way. This will bring us many opportunities to aid Veterans without duplicating the services already completed by another organization. We will also be able to send information for those Veterans we cannot assist. Assistance may consist of housing, food assistance, legal aid, rent and utilities, child assist, etc. We expect that this will be a very valuable tool as we promote our "Service Not Self" agenda.
