Despite shutdowns the SAL in Virginia is currently running a fundraiser for Children Welfare Foundation (CWF). The SAL Nationally as well as our squadron donates a great percentage from our charity fund to CWF. We have sold 50 beautifully adorned aprons throughout the State.
