## **Protection from Predatory Claims Practices**

America's wounded veterans have earned their benefits through their sacrifice and service. Sadly, some nonaccredited businesses seek to prey on our most vulnerable veterans and take advantage of this complicated process to make a quick buck. Some firms charge excessively for assistance in filing VA claims, even promising to increase disability ratings or to get veterans disability in the first place. This is especially bad if warriors are tricked into signing a contract.

Veterans should look out for some of the following tactics: Promises or guarantees to increase disability ratings and secure "X" amount percentage increases.

Companies advertising services that are done faster or better than a veteran's service organization or accredited agents.

Requesting sensitive login credentials to access the veteran's info through secure VA websites like eBenefits or VA.gov.

Using confusing tactics or ambiguous language in contracts designed to mislead the veteran.

Offering health consultation within their own network of doctors and telling veterans to forego VA exams for a faster decision.

The service officers at this Post are accredited by the Veterans Administration to help any veteran or family member file a claim for benefits at NO CHARGE. We are available Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM (except holidays). For God and Country, Bob DeChamplain
